



## PHOTOCOPYING REGULATIONS:

The BCHNS Archives provides photocopy and photographic reproduction services for a fee. The Archives reserves the right to restrict reproduction of its materials due to condition, size or donor restrictions. Reproduction of material does not constitute permission to publish. The archivist should be informed of the intention to publish or display any information found in the collection but the researcher is responsible for all copyright issues. (See Researcher Application and Conditions of Access for BCHNS Archives) Researchers are responsible for observing all of Canada's copyright laws.

1. For any material acquired from the archives and used in a Publication or for a Display, the researcher must make proper acknowledgement to BCHNS Archives.
2. Certain original historic photographs may require professional duplication. The researcher will bear the costs for this service.
3. The Archivist or a member of the Archives Committee will carry out photocopying of archival material within the confines of the archives office.
4. With the permission of the Archivist, researchers may use electronic devices to copy specified documents and photographs within the confines of the archival office.
5. Reproductions may not be further duplicated or subsequently be disseminated.
6. Reproductions may not be altered or manipulated through colour nor by being superimposed, transposed or changed in any other way.
7. A schedule of fees and costs may be obtained from the Archivist. Payment will be made for photocopying prior to collection of the documents.
